- Combermere Combermere's Lookout Park offers panoramic views of Kamaniskeg Lake, while Crooked Slide Park features a reconstructed logging chute from the early 1900s. Grab some pizza and head to the beach, or stay and dine at a patio, bistro or café.
- Barry's Bay Barry's Bay has plenty of options to fuel up and refresh, including fast food, patios, cafés, chip truck and bistros. Visit the historic railway station or the Avro Arrow monument, then drive to Lakeshore Park and stroll the sandy beach.
- Wilno Wilno is brimming with culture and hospitality.

 St. Mary's Catholic Church offers stunning views of the valley, while the local pub serves Polish cuisine with a local twist. The Kashub Heritage Park brings the area's pioneer roots to life.
- Killaloe In Killaloe, take a break at Station Park and follow the historic rail path to the covered bridge overlooking Brennan's Creek Falls. Enjoy a picnic lunch from the nearby chip truck, or grab a locally roasted coffee at the café.
- Eganville In Eganville, explore history and geology, complete with fossil hunts. Visit the Countdown Monument, or witness the power of the Bonnechere River at McRae Lookout Park. Refresh at the café or chip truck, or opt for a patio or bistro.
- Pikwàkanàgan The Algonquins of Pikwàkanagàn First Nation welcome visitors to their vibrant community.

 Explore culture and art at the Algonquin Way Cultural Centre, featuring canoes, dance regalia, stone tools, and more. Chip trucks, a restaurant, and gas stations are all nearby.
- Quadeville Quadeville is tucked in the hills along the Lower Madawaska River, a popular spot for whitewater kayaking and canoeing. Hunt for minerals and semiprecious gems at the Beryl Pit, then stop at the chip truck or general store for refreshments.
